



YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Mission of the Scottish American Society of Dunedin (SAS) is to promote and preserve the Scottish Arts and Culture in Pinellas County. We do this, in part, by assisting students who are enrolled in Scottish arts programs, usually piping, dancing and drumming, but other programs may be considered.

The aim of the Scottish American Society of Dunedin is to make these programs available to as many students as we can. We will therefore offer a limited number of scholarships on a monthly basis to students participating in a recognized Scottish Arts program within Pinellas County.

RULES:

1. Students must be no more than 18 years old and currently enrolled in one of the Scottish Arts Programs in Pinellas County.
2. Students can apply once per calendar year.
3. Applications will be considered at each monthly meeting of the SAS Executive Board.
4. Applications must be in writing (*or email*) and received no later than the 15th of the month to be considered.
5. Applications must include an essay of no less than 300 words describing their need.
6. All scholarship applications **MUST** be signed by their instructor/coach. Additional support from teachers or supporters is preferred.
7. All successful applicants will be expected to perform at least once at a General Meeting of the membership or other event of the SAS.
